

NUISANCE DOG POLICY

Adopted by the GSPOA Board of Directors:

Policy:

1. After a written complaint is filed, a letter is sent to the property owner informing them of the concern and the specifics of the complaint. They have 30 days to respond in writing with a plan for mitigation. If they do not respond in 30 days, they will be issued a first offense fine.
2. If a reasonable plan is received and accepted, and a subsequent concern is filed, the owner will be sent notice of the new concern. They have 30 days to respond in writing with a revised plan. If they do not respond, they will be issued a first offense fine.
3. If an owner never responds or does not implement their accepted plan, and the dog continues to generate concerns, they will be issued a fine for each valid complaint.
